### Sports bar mooves into Black Angus

Black Angus is putting its stake in the sports bar business with the opening of BullsEye Bar @ Black Angus, 5075 N. Oracle Road.

The Los Altos-based Calif.-Black Angus Steakhouse opened the casual sports bar Jan. 28. The bar has 11 hi-def TVs and free WiFi and seats 120.

Located to the right of the entrance, the sports bar has its own menu, which boasts dishes heavy on the beef, including steak nachos, filet mignon sliders, a shaved prime rib "burger" and bacon-wrapped beef hot dogs. Patrons can also order off Black Angus' dinner menu.

Signature drinks include the Pineapple Jalapeño Chelada, which is a bottle of Corona, pineapple and fresh lime juices with jalapeño slices and lime wedges, and a BullsEye Bomber, with Red Stag Cherry Bourbon by Jim Beam, Amaretto and Red Bull.

Happy hour is 4 to 7 p.m. Mondays through Fridays with \$3-\$5 drinks and appetizers. The bar is open from 3 to 10 p.m. Mondays through Fridays; 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. Saturdays; and 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. Sundays.

The BullsEye Bar is a growing concept within the national chain. Of the 46 Black Angus restaurants, 29 will have BullsEye Bars. The first opened in September 2009 in Burbank, Calif. To date, there are 17, with 12 planned this year.

A spokeswoman said that customers missed "the energy of our Square Cow Fun Bar," the nightclub that used to be inside Black Angus restaurants. She said that was a driving force in the sports bar's creation .
